INFORMATION REGARDING MASTER'S DEGREE

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY

1. The Dietetic Internship is part of the Master's program. No one can start the internship unless he/she is fully matriculated in the graduate program. This applies to you, whether or not you have an advanced degree.

3. The MS degree within the department is a 36 credit degree in Nutrition and Exercise Sciences (code # 329). You should choose one of the three emphases within this degree. If you choose the NU (Nutrition) emphasis, six of the twelve internship credits may be used to satisfy your degree requirements. If you choose the NE (Nutrition and Exercise) emphasis or the EX (Exercise Science) emphasis, your internship credits will not be able to be used to satisfy the degree requirements.
