- 60.4% of the Undergraduates are Female
- 39.4% of the Undergraduates are Male

- Female Students graduate at Higher Rates from Queens College than their Male counterparts based on a follow-up of the Fall 2002 entering First Time Full-time Freshmen Cohort.
