Students who wish to become a Communication Sciences & Disorders (CSD) major (Code 100-Speech Pathology) must formally apply to the Linguistics & Communication Disorders Department for admission into the major. To apply, applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 (B) and completed at least 24 credits from a regionally accredited college or university. Students not meeting these requirements will not be considered. Transfer students may apply for the major once they have been accepted by Queens College. Applicants should review the program of study and retention requirements for this major. These are available on the LCD website, on-line undergraduate college bulletin, or in the LCD Department.

There is limited space within the major. Consequently, the admission process is competitive. The undergraduate CSD admissions committee will review all applications received by the due date. Following the competitive process, students will be notified of acceptance or non-acceptance in the major for the upcoming semester. Unfortunately, all qualified students who meet the minimum requirements for application may not be admitted to the major due to limited space availability. Those students may reapply, however, the following semester if they so choose.
