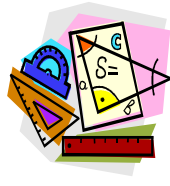


## Courses and Majors



- It is **important** that you schedule an initial visit to Ms. Pierce-Anyan or another academic adviser to review your academic plan.
- It is **imperative** that you see Ms. Maureen Pierce-Anyan, the Pre-professional Advisor for Minority Students, if you anticipate attending graduate or professional school immediately after graduation.
- Can't find the major that fits you well? There are interdisciplinary majors (typically combine two subject areas) that accommodate students who are not satisfied with the traditional majors offered.
- Remember, declaring your major means that you are allowed to pre-register for classes in that department.
- If a course is closed you can request an over-tally through the department, look for an evening or weekend course (those courses tend to fill up more slowly).

## Other Helpful Hints

- Relationships with professors should be made and maintained, references should be secured or new references should be cultivated.
- Give a professor at **least** 2 weeks notice when requesting a reference.
