NOTIFICATION OF POLICY

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees of The City University of New York and the constituent colleges and units of The City University of New York to recruit, employ, retain, and promote employees and to admit and provide services for students without regard to race, color, gender, age, national origin, religion, disability, veteran status and sexual orientation.

The City University of New York as a public university system, adheres to Federal, State, and City laws and regulations regarding non-discrimination and affirmative action in employment, including, among others, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Sections 503 and 504 of the Rehabilitation Act 1973, Section 402 of the Vietnam Veterans' Readjustment Act of 1974, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Executive Order 11246, as amended, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. The "protected classes", as delineated in the Federal Executive Order (Black, Hispanic (including Puerto Rican), Asian/Pacific Islander, American Indian/Alaskan Native and Women), were expanded on December 9, 1976 by the Chancellor of The City University of New York, to include Italian-Americans, and the University has and will continue to exercise affirmative action for the "protected classes", including Italian-Americans.
