Jazz Camp

The Summer Jazz Camp at CPSM is designed to meet the needs of both beginning and experienced jazz performers, ages 12 and up. The workshop offers an intensive full-day program that maximizes performance time each day with three ensemble rehearsal periods, a midday performance forum, and daily master classes. Students also attend theory/improvisation and jazz listening classes each day.

Musical Theater Workshop
