Program Objectives

The annual Raphell Sims Lakowitz Scholarship was established to perpetuate the dedication Raphell demonstrated in the field of Clinical Psychology. During her short career she had already helped many people to accept or solve problems that would otherwise have been crippling. The Foundation is entrusting to the recipients of the scholarship her legacy of warmth, compassion, and intelligence. We hope they will give a full measure of themselves to carry forward these objectives.

Eligibility and Requirements

- 1) Applicants must be full-time undergraduate students majoring in Psychology at Queens College who have revealed insight, sensitivity, and creativity in working with mentally and emotionally ill people.
- 2) Applicants must agree to volunteer at Creedmore Hospital one-half day per week during the fall and spring semesters.
- 3) Applicants must have achieved an excellent academic record with approximately 17 credits in Psychology, and give evidence of a real need for financial assistance.
- 4) Applicants must submit a complete application to the Psychology Dept office (SB E318) by the deadline, along with one letter of recommendation.

Terms of Support

The stipend of \$1,000 for one year of undergraduate study is intended to be applied to the cost of tuition and textbooks. It will be awarded in two equal parts over the period of two semesters.
