Located in the heart of Paris near the Latin Quarter, Saint-Germain des Prés, and Montparnasse, the Institute of French Language and Culture at the Catholic Institute of Paris offers French language and culture courses at a variety of levels. ICP-ILCF professors are trained in teaching French as a foreign language and will provide attentive and skilled instruction. From Monday to Friday students will attend beginning, intermediate, or advanced level courses for three hours each morning. There is an on-site language lab and internet access for ILCF students. Housing is at the Fondation André Honorat, a student residence at the Cité Universitaire in Paris. Students will also participate in several activities organized by the Paris coordinating organization (Mission Interuniversitaire et Coordinatrice des Echanges Franco-Américaines/MICEFA).
